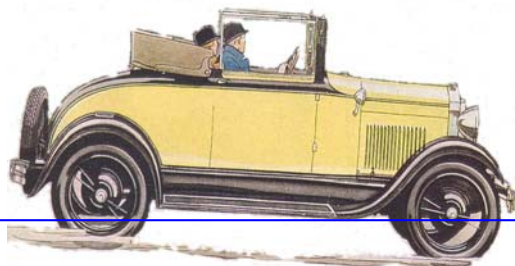

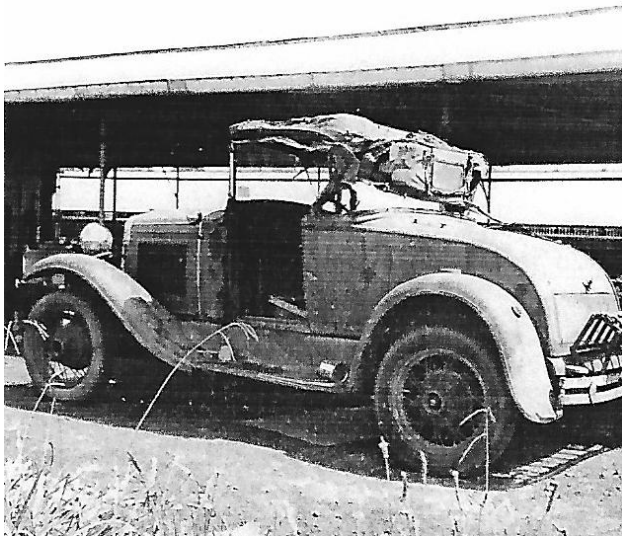
The story of Leon Panov's much travelled 1930 Roadster

I purchased my Roadster in 1965 from a retired coal miner at Buxton NSW. He drove her to work until 1957, then put her up on blocks where it sat for the next 8 years. I purchased the car for ten pounds which included a bonus petrol dipstick marked in gallons.

The engine was seized, so with the help of a mate we inflated the tyres and towed her home through town with dad's Massey Ferguson tractor. From 1965 she was a work in progress, and was finally finished and registered in 1995 (30 more years).

Since then I have clocked up over 40,000km, with 9,000km just recently in driving up and back to the Darwin Meet this year. Henry's lady has never missed a beat or let me down.
