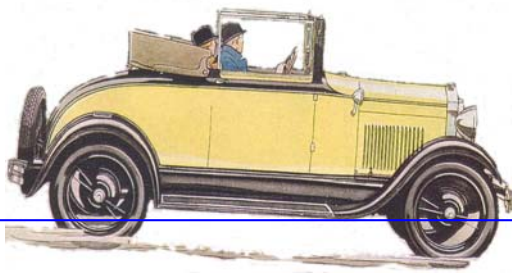

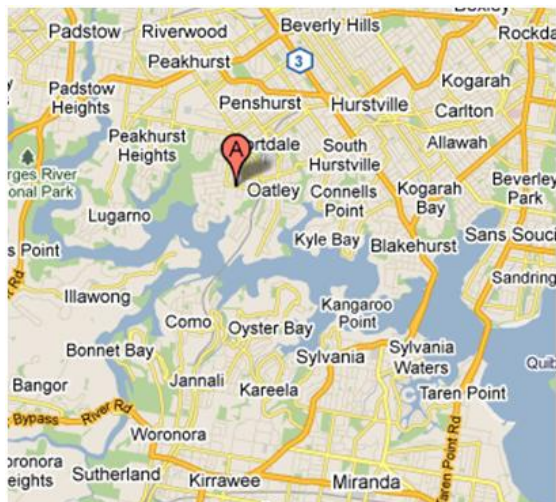

## *The Wanderers Outing Reports.*

### **Wednesday Wanderers Join The Riverboat Postman 4th September 2013.**



They kept arriving at the Brooklyn Wharf until there was a group of 34 comprised of members and their friends all keen to board the Riverboat Postman. The river and surrounds are really delightful and the Riverboat Postman trip is a great experience even if you may have travelled on it before.

On board we called briefly at Dangar Island which itself is worth a visit. We passed by the piers of the original rail bridge which became unsafe as they had been filled with rubble and had started to leach out.

Further on is the rusted remains of the destroyer HMAS Parramatta built in 1910 in Govan, Scotland for 82,500 pounds and which was the first commissioned warship of the RAN. The bow section is now on display at the northern end of Garden Island.

The return journey through a passage between Milson Island and the northern end of the

Muogamarra Reserve took us past an isolated feral community, called Milson Passage by those living there for want of a better name. Thank you Norm and Barb Boshers from all of us for organising such a wonderful day.

Garvin Institute was founded by the Sisters of Charity in 1963 as a small clinical research dept of St Vincent's Hospital in memory of James Patrick Garvan (1843-1896). It's main research is in most Cancer's, Diabetes, Obesity, Immunological Dis-

eases, Osteoporosis, Bone Biology & Neurological Diseases. After viewing the spectacular internal's with the Twin Helix stairways we used multiply lifts to arrive at conference room for a wonderful morning tea with a short video and talk from Diego a clinician from Spain about Breast Cancer. In all a wonderful morning of history and what the future hold's with their research into the Genome Area.
