### St Albans Run Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> November

**Note: This is a combined run for Central Coast members, Hunter Valley members and city members.**



The aim is to meet up at the Settler's Arms Inn at St Albans. This inn was built 1836 by convicts alongside the Macdonald River and located 20 kms north of Wiseman's Ferry. Worth looking at the website for St Albans NSW for maps, attractions and amenities. Phone the Settler's Arms Inn on 4568 2111 for enquiries or if wanting to stay the weekend. On Sunday either have a great lunch at the inn if you wish or bring your own.

**City members** should meet at Maroota on Old Northern Rd for morning tea at 10 am leaving at 10.30 am for Wiseman's Ferry. On arrival turn left at police station and cross Hawkesbury River on Webbs Creek ferry. Head 20 kms north to St Albans. Alternatively go to the other ferry at the east end of town and take the Settler's Rd to St Albans. You might consider going one way and coming back the other road.

**Central Coast members** should make their own prior meeting arrangements by contacting Leon Panov on 4944 7581 or 0417 491 547. Turn off Newcastle Freeway at Peats Ridge. Follow sign directions to Wiseman's Ferry via Mangrove Mountain but do not take the ferry but continue past on the road which now becomes Settler's Rd and proceed 20 kms north to St Albans.

**Hunter Valley members** should take the back road from Wollombi to Bucketty turning right at the sign to Wisemans's Ferry and travel 35 kms to St Albans.
