Presidents Run Sunday 15th September to Vic Maberly's Indian Museum @ Cattai



Neville has organised a run on Sunday 15th September to Vic Maberley's - the caretaker and owner of a plethora of early motorcycles nestled in an Aladdin's Cave of principally Indian motorcycles.

His shed is full to the brim with a range of parts, many of them protected by iron oxide or layers of paint. The stock of frames, engines, rims, tyres, etc are almost beyond comprehension. Of course there were just a few other rare motorcycles: Long gone manufacturers such as Cleveland, Excelsior, Invincible Jap, NerACar and a few modern bikes filled the space not taken up by Vic's passion for Indian Motorcycles.

During this decade Indian became the largest motorcycle manufacturer in the world culminating in production of 32,000 units in 1913. In 1914 Indian were first with both electric lighting and an electric starter, although electric starters were "dropped" after just six years. Vic has almost a complete set of Indian Motorcycles either fully finished or in part restoration. Three of his bikes were displayed at the 101010 Concourse event which took place in Manly in October 2010. The 3 bikes were:-

A 1916 Indian Model H

- 1917 Indian Model O, horizontally opposed side valve of 257cc
- And Vic's favourite, a 1919 Indian Powerplus number...thanks which can be ridden reliably at close to

100km per hour using its 3 speed gearbox, but with only a rear brake care has to be exercised.
