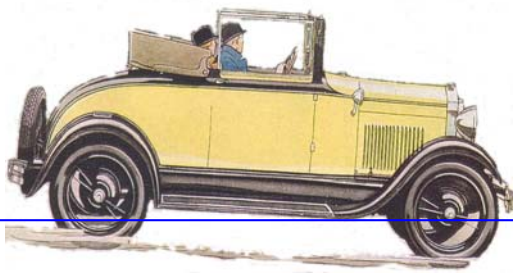

Such is progress! Thank you Don and Joan from us all. By Trevor Davis

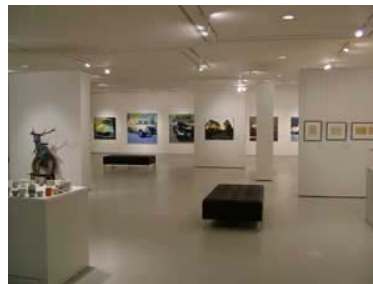
The Wanderers 7th May Outing—Windsor

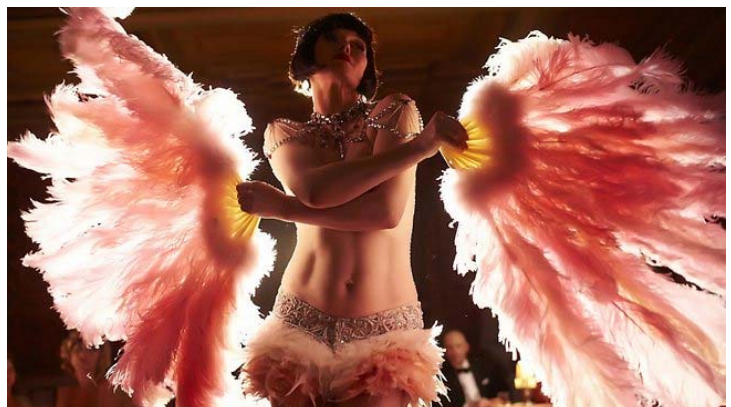

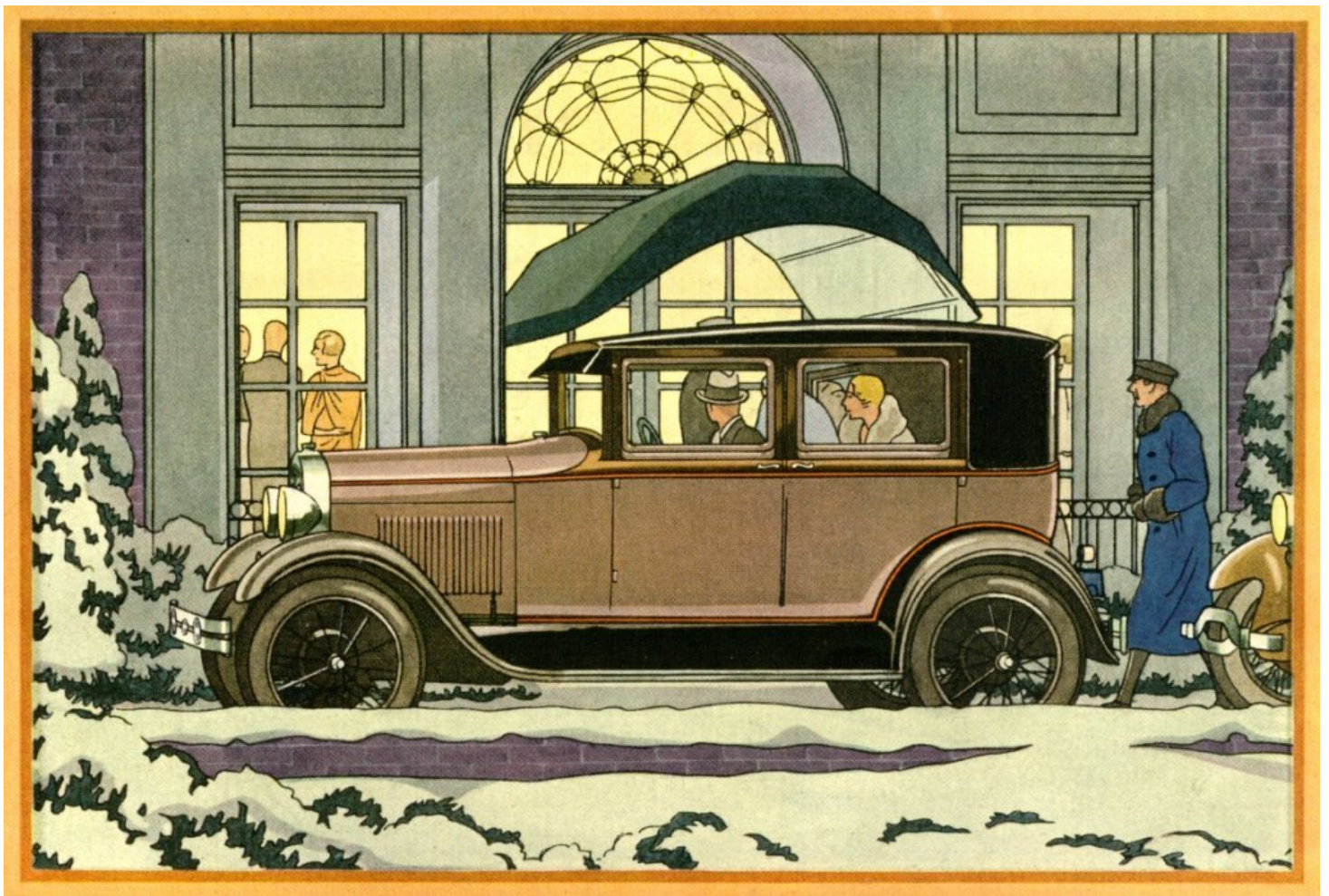
Miss Fishers Costume Exhibition - Old Government House Parramatta Park
