Worth looking at the website for St Albans NSW for maps, attractions and amenities. Phone the Settler's Arms Inn on 4568 2111 for enquiries or if wanting to stay the weekend. On Sunday either have a great lunch at the inn if you wish or bring your own.

City members should meet at Maroota on Old Northern Rd for morning tea at 10 am leaving at 10.30 am for Wiseman's Ferry. On arrival turn left at police station and cross Hawkesbury River on Webbs Creek ferry. Head 20 kms north to St Albans.
