Current COVID19 Restrictions.

SPARE POINTS ALERT: CHECK YOUR SPARE MODEL A POINTS

After COVID 19 lockdown, I went to shed to put new points in my spare distributor. To my astonishment I found the brand new packets of points that were under my seat did not fit and perhaps many others have same under their seat, but we would never be able to fit them on the roadside.



Bosch GF82V in Yellow Packet right (Made in Japan) which we have been using, have now been superseded by Bosh GF82V in Blue Packet centre (Made in Turkey). Without a lot of modifications, the Turkish Points will not fit in the distributor. Yellow GF82V are no longer available. The S82V Fuelmiser brand on left needs same modifications as Blue Turkish points.

The correct points are Brattons P/N 17450 sold in Australia by Dave Slater in Albury who has an advert in Model A Flyer. Dave was surprised about the issue as he had Bosch Turkish points in his store. As we have done a fair bit of research he is now currently ordering a good supply of the correct points from Brattons.

You may be lucky enough to still have the YELLOW box points, if not give the Blue Turkish ones to someone who has a Cortina as that is what they should fit.
