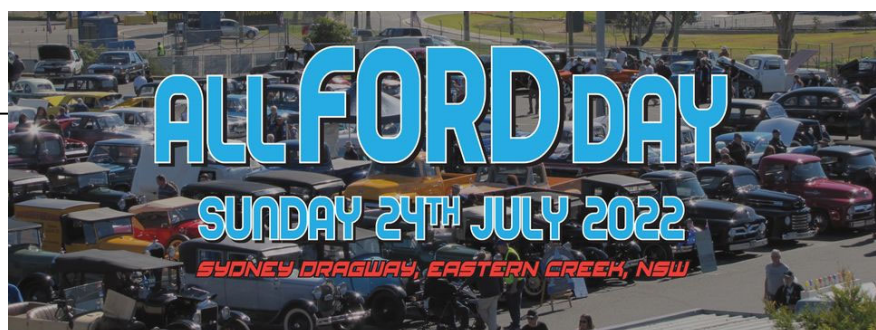
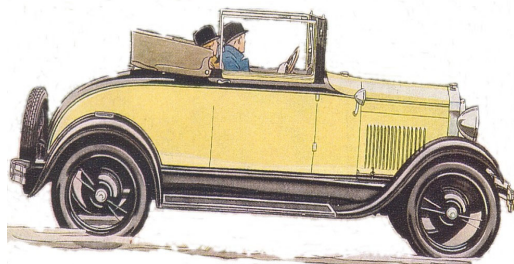

The All Ford Day is a family friendly event held on the last Sunday in July each year. Organised by The Combined Ford Clubs of New South Wales, the day celebrates all of Ford's finest. From trucks to drag cars and everything in between, come along and see over 1200 Ford vehicles on display.

The day is a "NO ALCOHOL" event and is open to the whole family. We have plenty of activities and

rides for the kids to enjoy, including face painting and pony rides. See some of the best original Ford vehicles in the country alongside some amazingly restored and modified examples. Arrival - Please arrive in your Model A between 7am & no later than 9am. Enter via Sydney Dragway Competitor Gate, Ferrers Road, Eastern Creek.
