- o When renewing registration – a copy of the Approved Safety Certificate (Pick Slip)

Wednesday Wanderers

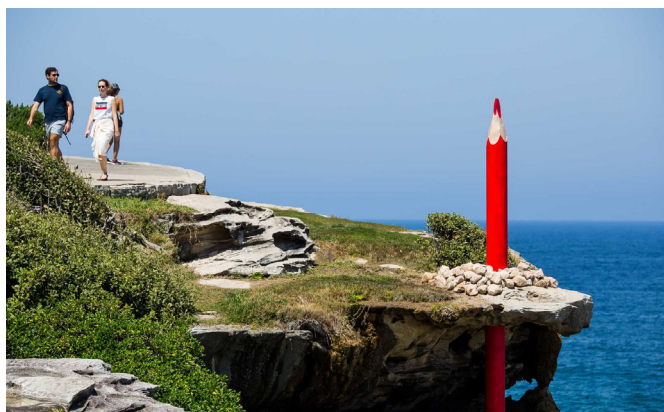
Wednesday 2nd November—Sculptures by the Sea

Putting more "Flash" into an after market coil



I was reading an article about how fine point judging works, a comment was made suggesting when an original component could not be used, a reproduction component, while not an accurate copy, painted the correct colour would still receive good points.

My friend Richard Nicholls and I were not satisfied with a generic coil and thought we could do better. In Australia it is very difficult to find original coils.

Richard has an early 1931 closed cab pick-up and I have a June 1930 Tudor, both cars have their original engines. According to the judging standards, our cars have the same coil with parallel terminals and without the Ford script.

To begin with we ordered 3 replacement coils with mounting brackets from the usual suppliers. On arrival we threw the mounting brackets in the scrap steel bin and fabricated our own.

We didn't have a sample to copy we had to estimate the size of the ribs around the coil and the size of the pressed top.

We rolled 2.4mm brazing wire around the coils and attached them with JB epoxy. I turned some alloy bar to look like the pressed metal tops and once again had to guess the size and shape by looking at photo's. Once these were made, we glued them to the coil with JB weld again.

We fabricated the mounting brackets to look as close to original as possible. The only concession we made to the original design was we bolted the brackets to the coil like the "re-pop" coils. The originals were spot welded and we thought it prudent not to try this. The original coil brackets were date stamped so we did this to suit our own cars.

The Judging Standards dictate our cars should not have a Ford script but should have the American Bosch symbol, the circled "A". To achieve this Richard made stick-on signs and when painted they looked great.

In an attempt to make them look correct we drilled a hole in the front of the mounting bracket and glued a rivet head to the coil body as OEM.

Finally, Richard painted 2K on the coil bodies and brackets and painted a Bakelite colour on the lower terminal area. We now have one for each car and a spare should we ever need one.

There is no doubt if you know what you're looking for you can pick them from OEM however few have realised what we have done. With a little effort it is possible to transform a bland generic coil to look more appealing to the restorer who cannot find a good original coil.

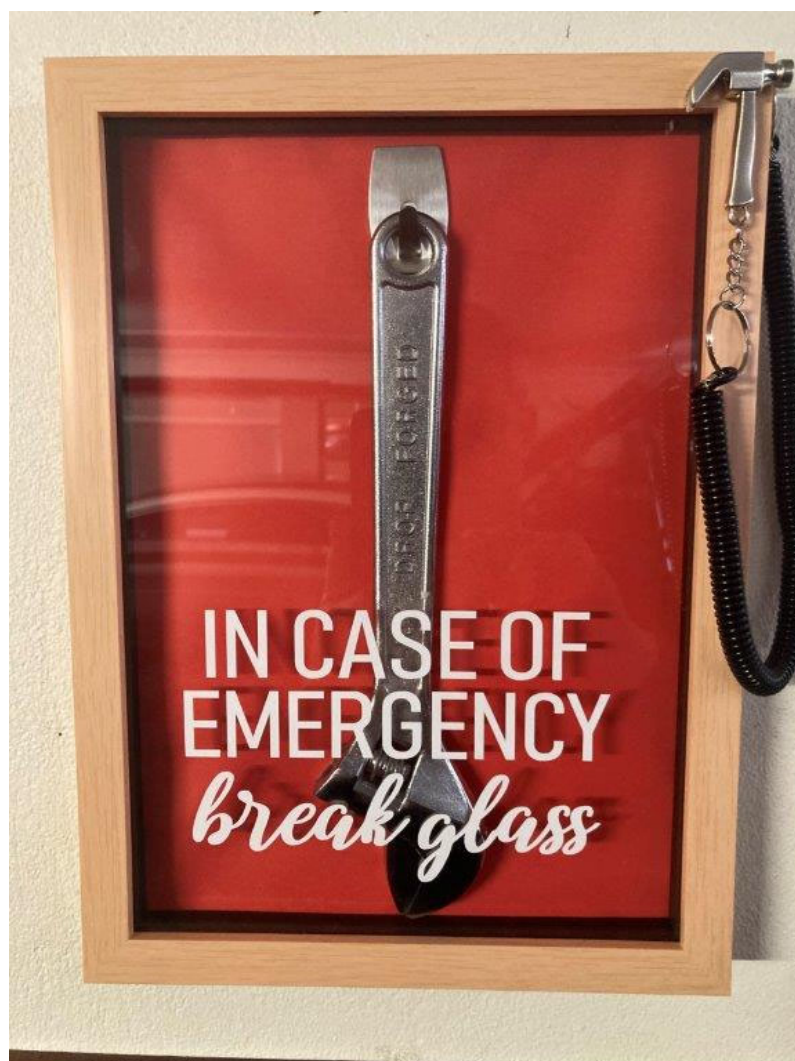

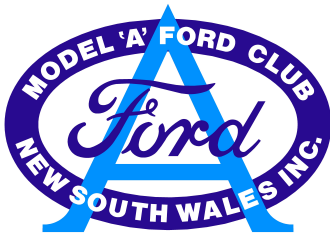
