Lennox with a selected group of convicts trained by Lennox in fine stonework, and was completed in July 1833. It was used for over 100 years as the main road westwards. It is the oldest stone bridge of its design in mainland Australia.

After viewing the bridge, we departed to The Lapstone Hotel. With a table reserved, we were able to sit together for lunch.



The food was great, the company was good, and the staff were first rate. About midafternoon, we all said goodbye and departed for home.


